Limited Review report on the Unaudited Standalone Financial Results for the Quarter ended on December 31, 2017

To the Board of Directors

Akar Auto Industries Limited

(Formerly known as Akar Tools Limited)

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statements of unaudited standalone financial results ('the statement') of Akar Auto Industries Limited (Formerly known as Akar Tools Limited) ('the Company') for the quarter ended December 31, 2017 being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as modified by Circular No. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016.

This Statement is the responsibility of the Company's Management and has been approved by the Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to issue a report on these financial statements based on our review.

- 2. We conducted our review in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the financial statements are free of material misstatements. A review is limited primarily to inquiries of the Company personnel and analytical procedures applied to financial data and thus provide less assurance than an audit. We have not performed an audit and accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Based on our review conducted as above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement prepared in accordance with applicable Indian Accounting Standards and other recognized accounting practices and policies, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 read with SEBI Circular no. CIR/CFD/FAC/62/2016 dated July 5, 2016, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

The Ind AS financial results and financial information for the quarter ended December 31, 2017 has not been subjected to audit and review and has been presented based on the information complied by the management after making necessary Ind AS adjustments to ensure true and fair view of the results in accordance with Ind
- There is a possibility that these quarterly financial results may require adjustment before constituting the final Ind As financial statement as at and for the financial year ending March 31, 2018 due to changes in financial reporting requirements arising from revised standard or interpretations issued by MCA / appropriate
- authority or changes in the use of one or more optional exemptions from full retrospective application of certain Ind As as permited under Ind AS-101. The Company is engaged in the business of "Automotive Components" and therefore, has only one reportable segment in accordance with Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments".



The Shares of the Company were sub-divided from the face value of Rs. 10 per share to Rs. 5 per share with effect from 1st December, 2017. Accordingly the Authorised Share Capital of the Company is Rs. 10,00,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Crores) divided into 2,00,00,000 (Two Crores) Equity Shares of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five) Crore Seven Lakhs Eighty Eight Thousand and Ten) Equity Shares of Rs. 5/- (Rupees Five) each. Earning Per Share (EPS) for the previous periods have been restated
